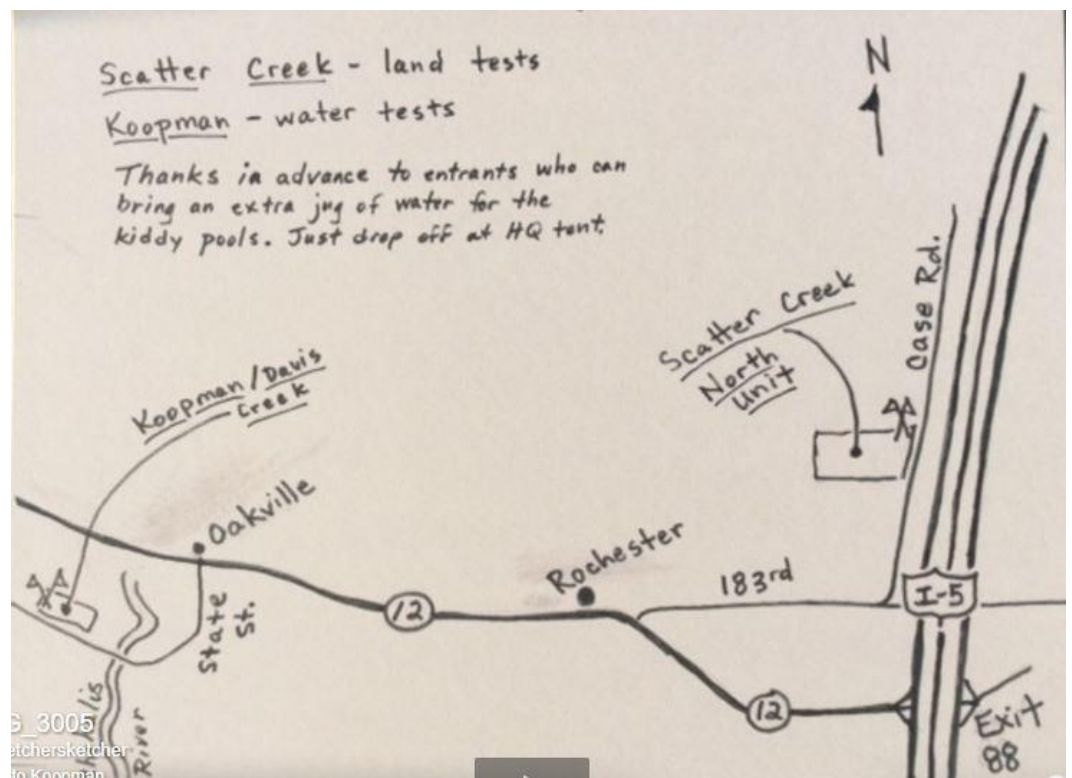


The water tests will now be conducted at Koopman Farm / Davis Creek WDFW Area. Directions below from the North Area and from I-5. Folks will caravan over as well. Directions below. Note: the day of we'll figure out a way to taxi from the land to the water and back. The parking area for the pond at Koopmans isn't large so vehicles must park so they're not taking up 2 or 3 spaces. And not block the road so the Pointer folks can get through if needed.

From the North Unit:

- Coming out of the parking lot, turn right and go south on Case Rd. for 1.4 miles
- Turn right on 183rd and go west for 3.5 miles
- Turn right at intersection with Hwy. 12
- Go west on Hwy. 12 through Rochester, and continue about 8 miles to Oakville
- Coming into Oakville turn left on State St. (it's about the second street, post office on corner).
- Go south on State St., after leaving town it will curve right and become S. Banks Rd.
- After Banks crosses the Chehalis River it is about 1.9 miles to the driveway for the pond at Koopman on the right (will be flagged), park off to the right by the building.

Note: You will go past the main Koopman parking lot. It will have trucks, horse trailers, RVs for a pointing breed event.



Directions to Koopman from I-5

- From I-5 take Exit 88 (Tenino / Aberdeen / Hwy. 12).
- Turn west towards Rochester (right if coming from the north, left coming from the south).
- Follow Hwy. 12 for about 13 miles to town of Oakville.
- Turn left on State St., it's about the second street, post office on corner.
- Continue south on State St., after leaving town it will curve right and become S. Banks Road.
- After Banks crosses the Chehalis River it is 1.9 miles to the driveway on the right for the pond at Koopman (will be flagged).
- It is past the main Koopman parking lot, which Sat. and Sun. will have trucks, horse trailers, RVs for a pointer event.
