Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

**Non-Regular Classes involving Single Dog Entries**

**Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs and class of bitches 7 years and under 10 years.

**Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs and class of bitches 10 years and older.

Note- Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Independent Breed Specialties.

**Stud Dog** - For Stud Dogs and of two their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get. Get MUST be entered in a Regular Class or Best of Breed Competition at this show. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the standard for the breed. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be marked "For Brace Only", fee is \$18.00 per dog. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in place provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class".

At the judges discretion, up to 6 (six) awards 3 dogs and 3 bitches will be awarded in the Best of Breed competition, which shall include move-ups. #### THE BREEDER'S SHOWCASE

The Breeder's Showcase Event will be held after sweepstakes judging at the National Specialty of the Clumber Spaniel Club of America. It is designed to reward breeders who through their individual breeding decisions and devotion to our breed have put together a family of Clumber Spaniels which demonstrate a long term commitment to producing quality examples of the breed.

For this introductory event, the judges will be selected by the show committee for the 2008 national. The 2008 national will also be holding the International Symposium and to help promote a global theme, the show committee will be choosing a panel of three foreign Clumber experts to judge this event.

#### RULES

1. When entering this event, a separate entry form exclusively for this event must be filled out. This special entry form will be in the premium list.
2. An entry will consist of a group of three (3) dogs from one pedigree and each dog must have a direct line relationship with each other. **Gender is of no consideration** and any combination of sexes is allowed as long as each generation is directly responsible for the next generation. For example: A sire followed by his daughter which is followed by her son.
3. All three of the dogs that make up the entry must have at least 1 breeder in common.
4. In the case of co-breederships of one or more of the dogs, the breeder or breeders who are consistent throughout all three generations will be the recipient of the Breeder of Distinction Award.
5. All of the dogs entered must meet the same eligibility requirements as for other AKC events.
6. At least one (1) dog from each family group must be entered in a regular class.
7. Spayed and neutered dogs may be shown in this event. All dogs from the family group that are entered in a regular class must meet the requirements as far as being spayed or neutered is concerned for the class that it is entered in.
8. A dog may only be entered in one (1) family grouping for this event.
9. The Breeder's Showcase entry form must be submitted along with a copy of at least one entry form of the dogs entered in a regular class.
10. A family of three generations is considered one entry and the entry fee will be the same as for one regular class.
11. The judging of the Breeder's Showcase class will be similar to the judging of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch class with the exception that each of the generations will be judged equally.
  - a) The judges should keep in mind the qualities of **Type, Soundness, Consistency of Quality and Improvement** from one generation to the next. Each of these criteria should be given equal weight when making a final decision.
  - b) Each of the three judges will rank each of the family groups in a most liked to least liked ranking, with a rating of 1st to however many entries there may be in the class. The scores from all three judges will be totaled and the family group with the highest average ranking will be the winner of the event. There will only be one overall winner with no other award being given than 1st. In case of a tie the three judges will vote between the two family groups that are tied.
