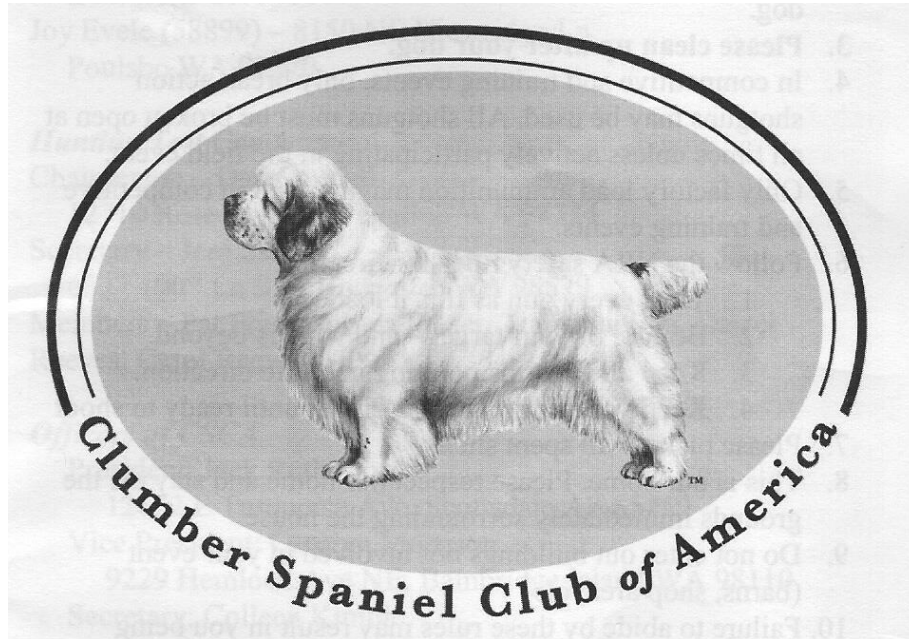

PLEASE NOTE: VEHICLE USE PERMIT REQUIRED

The Washington Dept. of Fish & Wildlife now requires a Vehicle Use Permit for Scatter Creek & Other WDFW improved access facilities. Permits can be purchased anywhere that sells hunting/fishing licenses and online at <https://fishhunt.dfw.wa.gov/wdfw/vup.html>

SAFETY: An item of blaze orange clothing must be worn by field marshals, bird planters, handlers, gunners, judges, and all members of the gallery. CSCA will have blaze orange vests

available for guests to borrow. Also, the club asks that you refrain from smoking while in the field.

SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN PARKING AREA

A REMINDER: Please remember that training of dogs is not permitted on any part of the grounds the day of a test. You are asked to keep your dog on a leash or confined when not on the course being tested.

DIRECTIONS – FROM I-5:

FROM THE NORTH....

Take Exit #95 toward Little Rock. Turn LEFT on Case Rd. and continue south for several miles. Shortly after crossing Scatter Creek turn RIGHT on 180th, then RIGHT on Guava (“T” in Road). The gravel road turns in to Area 1’s Parking lot.

FROM THE SOUTH....

Take Exit #88 toward Rochester. Turn RIGHT at stop light and go north on Elderberry. Turn RIGHT on 193rd, then LEFT on Guava and continue north for several miles (there’s a short jog right at 183rd). Guava ends in a gravel road which turns in to Area 1’s parking lot.

Units camping on site must be self-contained.
