

Hello all, and thanks for being patient with us, as we work through the cancellation, and rescheduling of our 2020 CSCA National. Here is the information we have received so far.

- Deposits for the Grooming Spaces/RV's have never been cashed, so the Columbia Kennel Club will contact you and mail the checks back to you.
- Vendors will be contacted by Chic Denney, and if you want a refund, she will take care of that for you.
- We previously notified everyone that the Hotel is refunding the \$100 room deposit.
- Tracking entries will be sent back by Colleen Kimble, Tracking Chair.
- Hunting entries are being fully refunded, as was previously stated.
- Scentwork shredded the applications and the checks.
- Top 10 Entries will not be refunded. The monogrammed rosettes have been received as well as engravings and will be used at the later date which is currently in the planning stages.
- Top 10 Dinners and Banquet Dinners. The payments for both Dinners will not be refunded at this time, as we plan to have both events at the new reschedule event. If you will not be attending the new event please contact Trish Gregory, she will take see that you are refunded for the meals that you are unable to attend.
- Trophy Sponsorships will not be refunded.
- Ad Book purchases will not be refunded, as that will move forward with the new event.
- Conformation Entries. We are waiting on a spreadsheet from Onofrio, to let us know how much of our entry fees will be refunded to us. The club will not be keeping any fees, but Onofrio will be keeping processing fees, and the AKC normally will keep their fee also. Inquiries have been made to see if it would be possible to wave those charges, but an answer has yet to come. I spoke with them yesterday, but they've had many shows cancelled, so it will take them awhile to get us that information. I will let you know as soon as I hear from them.
